



Swimming Lessons

A working party met recently to review costs related to school swimming lessons. Parents are currently asked for a voluntary contribution of £3.50 per child per week, to cover the cost of the lesson and the bus.

The number of voluntary contributions received is falling well short of the level required and there is a real concern at the level of subsidy needed from the school budget.

Therefore, with regret, we will have to cancel swimming lessons from September 2016 unless contributions increase.
