Hipsburn Mission Statement:

"The most valuable gift we can give a learner is to enable them to think for themselves, to care for others and thereby acquire a sense of self-worth and confidence which can be used to benefit both society and the individual."

Purpose:

This policy is designed to support the school's aim to encourage children to take their place as active members of the world community, developing individual strengths and being tolerant and respectful of their selves and others.

General Principles:

1. To encourage pupils to develop the habit of charitable giving
2. To promote involvement in the local, national and international communities
3. To give pupils opportunities to show individual initiative
4. To give pupils opportunities to plan and carry out projects, individual or as members of a group / class or the whole school.
5. To foster links between year groups through co-operation in fund raising activities.

Aims:

- To raise money for a variety of local, national and international charities.
- To raise awareness of the vital role that charities play in improving lives of others.
- To support charities in ways other than donating money.
- To clarify and limit the financial and time commitment of parents and staff to specified charitable events.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Class teachers will ensure that pupils are able to take advantage of any opportunities to support charities.
- School staff will publicise the school's charity activities both in and out of school.
- Pupils and the School Council will be encouraged to organise specific activities.

Charity Events:

Below is an initial timetable of events and fund raising activities linked to the school year. This allows staff and parents to look ahead and see what events children will be invited to and join in with.
