## Early Years Pupil Premium

Dear Parents.

Early Years Pupil Premium is extra funding for Early Years providers to further enhance the early years provision for your child; supporting their development, learning and care.

The Early Years Pupil Premium could provide extra funding of up to £302 per year. This funding can be used in any way each childcare provider chooses in order to improve the quality of the early years education provided. This could be:

- additional training for staff on early language
- investing in partnership working with colleagues in the area to further expertise
- supporting staff in working on specialised areas such as speech and language.

## Is my child eligible for the Early Years Pupil Premium?

Your child may be eligible for the EYPP if you receive any of these benefits:

- · Income Support
- · Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- · Income-related Employment & Support Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- · The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided that you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- · Working Tax Credit run-on

## There is also extra funding available if your child:

- · Has been looked after by the local authority for at least one day
- · Has been adopted from care
- · Has left care through a special guardianship
