Early Reading

Books / reading is key to learning.

 Parents are the child's first teachers in helping children to read and love books.

 Stories can help develop imagination and language.

The Reading Process

- Environmental, voice, body and instrumental sounds are needed to first distinguish sounds.
- · Beat, rhythm, rhyme and alliteration
 - explore sounds.
- Alphabet sounds.
- Playing with words.
