## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS (feel free to include other information)

Your project should have a front cover, designed to show off what your country is all about!

Your project should have an INTRODUCTION which includes:

- The name of the country
- The major language(s) spoken
- The capital of the country
- The location (which continent is it on?)

Your project should have at least one paragraph discussing the HISTORY of your country which includes:

- The date the country came into existence.
- Major events in the country's history.
- Famous people/rulers/kings/ presidents/etc. from the country's history.
- How the country became a country.

Your project should have at least one paragraph discussing the GEOGRAPHY of your country. It should include:

- Major landforms.
- Major bodies of water.
- Major landmarks.
- Major cities.

Your project should have at least one paragraph discussing the CULTURE of your country. It should include:

- Clothing
- Religions
- Music
- Food
- Holidays
- Government

Your project should have at least one paragraph discussing the ECONOMY of your country. It should include:

- Natural Resources
- Major occupations (jobs)
- Manufacturing areas
- The currency (type of money)
- Land use (ie. farming areas)

Your project should have at least one paragraph discussing the CLIMATE of your country. It should include:

- General weather conditions
- Average yearly temperature
- Average yearly rainfall
- What effects the climate has on the country
- Consider including a graph in this section!

Your project should have at least one paragraph discussing any INTERESTING FACTS about your country. It could include:

- Population
- Strange laws
- Modes of transportation
- Travel tips
- Story behind the flag
- Native animals

Your project should have a CONCLUSION paragraph which should be a summary of your research.

You should use the internet, books, etc. for your research and you may choose to present it in any way your wish- this could be either handwritten or typed.
