## Results Bulletin | 2017-2018 Attainment

We are delighted to be able to share our pupil attainment data for the academic year 2017-2018. This was the first year that we have operated as a full primary school with pupils in Year 6 completing their Key Stage 2 SATs. The outcome couldn't have been more important.

This was a great year for the pupils of Hipsburn Primary School and we are very proud of their outstanding achievements! Our Year 6 pupils achieved some of the best results in the Alnwick Partnership and outperformed the national average.

Children are assessed, in line with Ofsted requirements, at several stages during their Primary education: at the end of Early Years (Reception), Year 2 (Key Stage 1 SATs) and Year 6 (Key Stage 2 SATs). In addition to these mandatory assessments, we use a half-termly <u>assessment system</u> from <u>**Rising Stars**</u> to check individual and group pupil progress in core subjects (maths, reading, spelling, punctuation & grammar) to ensure that we deliver the best possible education for your child.

While we are waiting for the 2018 national averages to be published, we have compared our results to the national averages of 2017 as well as the 2018 average for the 13 primary schools in the Alnwick Partnership.

**Early Years** | Children are assessed at the end of Reception to see if they have achieved a Good Level of Development. As you can see, we **outperformed the national average and the Alnwick Partnership**.

Our <u>Year 1</u> children did brilliantly well with **93% achieving the phonics check** versus **85% average across the Alnwick partnership** and a 2017 **national average of 81%**.

**Key Stage 1** | Our Year 2 children completed their Key Stage 1 SATs and outperformed the 2017 national average and 2018 Alnwick Partnership average in all areas.
